Within the traditions and history of the game of golf and the etiquette, we strive for a casual and informal atmosphere at our club. However, this does not exclude correct attire on the golf course and the driving range and in the clubhouse. Clothing should generally be described as 'appropriate golf clothing'. Please take note of our guidelines:

- Trousers or Bermuda shorts for men (no shorter than just above the knee).
- Trousers, Bermuda shorts, golf skirts and dresses for the ladies.
- Polo or golf shirt (with collar) for the ladies.
- Polo with collar and sleeves for men.
- On the golf course it is mandatory to wear golf shoes or golf boots.
- Hats and caps off in the clubhouse.
- It's a good habit to change clothes and footwear before prize giving and appear well-groomed. For the gentlemen wearing a blazer is appreciated.
- At our golfclub the following clothes aren't considered appropriate golf clothing: jogging suits, tracksuits and other sportswear, tank tops or spaghetti tops, cropped jumpers and tops and other clothes that don't cover in an appropriate manner, jeans with frayed hems, holes and/or tears.
