

DRESS CODE:

With respect for the traditions and history of the game of golf and etiquette, we strive for a casual and informal atmosphere. However, this does not exclude correct attire on the course, the driving range and in the clubhouse. In general, attire should be able to be called 'appropriate for golf'. As a guideline, the following can be used:

- Trousers or Bermuda shorts (for men just above the knee). For women Bermuda shorts or golf skirts or dresses
- Polo or golf shirt (with collar) for the ladies
- Polo with collar and sleeves for the men
- On the course it is mandatory to wear golf shoes or golf boots
- In the clubhouse caps and hats off
- For award ceremonies it is a good habit to dress up and appear with a well-groomed outfit and footwear. For men, a jacket is appreciated
- Jogging suits, tracksuits and other sportswear, tops, belly button tops and other 'revealing' clothes, jeans with thrums, frills, holes and/or tears are not considered appropriate golf clothes.
